Host Club Policies

Cell Phone Policy: Cell phones may only be used on the golf course in case of an emergency, a ruling, entering hole-by-hole scores, viewing tournament leaderboard, weather forecasts, or as a distance measuring device. We ask that phones are set to silent while on club grounds. Silent communications (text, email) may be used inside buildings. Verbal communication (phone calls) must be outside buildings.

Parking: There is a limited amount of parking available at the host club and we ask players, caddies and family members to carpool as much as possible.

Dress Code: Appropriate golf attire must be worn. Slacks or Bermuda shorts. No cut-offs, no denim, no cargo pants, or cargo shorts. Men must wear shirts with collars and sleeves, always tucked in. Non-metal spikes only. Dress code applies to players, caddies, and spectators.

Coolers: Personal coolers are not allowed.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the JGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Practice Rounds and Practice Facility

You are entitled to **one** practice round. A block of practice round times have been blocked between 2-3:03 PM on Tuesday, July 9, 2024. You may call the golf shop to reserve a **weekday** practice round tee time at another time. Make sure to identify yourself as a registered JGA Tour participant. It would be helpful if you made your own group before calling. Do not just show up at the course and expect to be accommodated for a practice round. There is a **mandatory** \$35.00/player fee for the practice round, which does NOT include range balls. Players are limited to playing one ball except from the teeing ground. Players are welcome to use the practice range and putting green throughout the tournament.

Starting Times

Starting times for July 10th will be available on July 3rd by 5:00pm. Check the JGA website at www.juniorgolfalabama.org or call the JGA office.

Championship Format and Schedule

- 36 holes of gross individual stroke play for players 9-13 and 14-18 Age Divisions.
- 18 holes (9 holes each day) for 6-8 or 9-11 Age Divisions.
- The lowest score for 36 holes in the divisions (9-11, 12-13 and 14-18 Age Division) will be the Divisional Champions.
- Any ties in divisions will be resolved by matching scorecards according to the USGA recommendation within the Committee Procedures of the Rules of Golf – "Matching Scorecards"
- Initial groupings will be for Round 1. Players will be re-paired by score for the Final Round.

Tuesday, July 9 Practice Round tee times blocked between 2-3:03 PM. Range balls not included.

Wednesday, July 10 Round 1: Tee times at 10:06 AM off #1 (All players)

The field re-grouped according to score.

Thursday, July 11 Round 2: Tee times at 10:06 AM off #1 (All players)

Pace of Play

The JGA wants all players to enjoy competing in our events. Pace of play may differ depending upon the venue, weather, and course conditions. Every player is accountable for playing at an acceptable pace; therefore, we need your help. Please observe the following guidelines to help ensure a pleasant tournament experience for all:

- Make sure to keep pace with the group in front of you. The group behind should keep pace with your group and so forth.
- · Go directly to your ball.
- Be ready to play when it is your turn.
- · Keep practice strokes and time taken to read putts to a minimum.
- Play a provisional ball if your original ball may be lost or out of bounds.
- Keep time taken at the snack bar or between nines to a minimum.

If everyone does their part, then 4½ hours should be the maximum time taken to play a round of golf at an JGA tournament. Following the lead of the USGA, the JGA has developed a pace of play policy, based on Rule 5.6b and Model Local Rule 8K that is fair to every competitor. *Note: a group may receive a "friendly reminder" of their position regardless of pace of play guidelines.

Maximum Allowable Time

The maximum allowable time is the maximum time considered necessary by the Committee for a group to complete its round. This is expressed in a per-hole and aggregate time format and includes all time associated with playing the game, e.g., for rulings and walking times between holes.

Both the specific maximum time allotted per hole and for the completion of 18 holes at JGA tournaments will be denoted on each player's JGA issued scorecard.

See the complete JGA Pace of Play Policy for the procedure if a group is "out of position" and penalty for breach of Pace of Play Policy.

- A competitor's time to play begins when the competitor has had a reasonable opportunity to reach his or her ball and when it is the competitor's turn to play and can do so without interference or distraction. Penalties are applied individually, but more than one competitor in a group may be penalized.
- In general, competitors in a group are subject to being timed at any time but specifically when the group is deemed to be out of position and over the allotted pace of play guidelines.

Note that a group that is out of position at any time may be asked to close the gap regardless of pace of play guidelines. A group is out of position if they are over their maximum acceptable pace of play and more than 15 minutes behind the group ahead of them. The first group off either side is out of position if they are over their maximum acceptable pace of play.

Range Fees; Push Carts

- Practice Rounds: Practice round fees are not included in the entry fee.
- Tournament Site: All range fees during the tournament rounds are paid by the JGA and are included in the entry fee. Entry fee provides for one (1) bag of range balls on event day(s). Competitors must walk during tournament rounds. Push carts are allowed.

Caddies

- Caddies are not allowed in the 9-13 and 14-18 age divisions.
- Parents / Guardians are allowed to caddie for the 6-8 and 9-11 (9-hole) age divisions only and must walk.

Spectators

- Spectator Cart Policy: JGA defers to host club policy regarding allowing spectator carts at junior tournaments. If spectator carts are allowed, they will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis and limited to ONE spectator cart per pairing with priority given to spectators holding a state-issued ADA placard.
- Disability Golf Cart Policy: Consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), JGA will grant an individual with a bona fide disability a golf cart if the following conditions are met:
 - o Requesting individual completes and submits a Disabled Golf Cart Request Form by the close of entries date.
 - The host club has a golf cart available.
 - o Requesting individual pays host club, the appropriate fee.
 - o Requesting individual presents to the JGA staff or JGA representative a disability card issued by a government agency.
- Spectator carts must always remain on the cart path and spectators must adhere to the club's dress code policy.
- Non-club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the JGA Tournament Manual.

Prizes & Awards

Awards will be presented as follows:

- Top 3 in Male Age Divisions: 6-8, 9-11 (9- and 18- hole divisions), 12-13, 14-18
- Top 3 in Female Age Divisions: 6-8, 9-11 (9- and 18-hole divisions), 12-13, 14-18
